Dear Daemen Students,

The recent \$2 illion stimulus package passed by the deral government included \$14 billion in funds for institutions of higher education hose funds are awarded to a college based on a formula using Pell eligible students. Daemen College is expected to receive approximately 000 to be used exclusively to assist students and their families for "direct payment of grants to students for their expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and chiddre." Daemen has created straightforward and simple process for students to apply.

Any student who is registered foourses this summer and/or this fall, and has experienced a financial hardship as a result of COVID9, may complete a brief application for funds. The application, which will be available the campus community in the near futurel ask some basic questions and ask students to the impact and their request. The application will then be reviewed confidentially by a small committee chaired by Financial Aid and include a professional staff member from the Divisions of Student Affairs, Acadenic Affairs, and Diversity and Inclusion.

Decisions will be made and awards allotted directly/toolents on a firstsome, firstserved basis. The DOE suggests a maximum individual award of \$6,196,final decisions will be made based on the impact on the student and other objective criteria including a review of information on the FAFSA. More detailed instructions and criteria will be sent out in the near future.

We know how trying all of this has been students and their families. We are hop that this grant will provide a little glimmer of hope and support as you finish this semester and register for the semester ahead.
